Jacopo graduated in Philosophy of Mind and Language (B.A.) from San Raffaele University (Milan), with a dissertation on formal ontology entitled “A World without Objects. An Essay in Non-Standard Ontology” (110 *summa cum laude* and a special mention as a further distinction). He received his M.A. from the same institution with a dissertation on logic, epistemology and complexity science (“Complex Sigillum Veri. An Experiment in Non-Standard Modelling” - 110 *summa cum laude* and again a special mention).

His multidisciplinary attitude shaped Jacopo's education and research methods: he studied microeconomics (London School of Economics), statistics (New York University) and complexity (Santa Fe Institute). He gave his first speech at SIFA (Italian Society for Analytic Philosophy) when he was 23 and published several articles in peer-reviewed journals.

He has been working with iLabs since 2006, and he is currently iLabs main supervisor for projects in qualitative modelling and vice-director of AI department and quantitative applications.
